

35 and Over Team Eligibility For Tournament Play

- 35 and over teams may play in open “C” tournaments if their ENTIRE roster is comprised of players who play no higher than open “C”. This includes players from teams reclassified no higher than “C” from the previous year.
- Any 35 and over team with a player who plays on a “B” or above team, or a player whose team was reclassified “B” or above the previous season can play no lower than open “B” tournaments.

RETURNING TEAM

- Any team that has four (4) or more players from any combination of teams moved up within the same classification, or players from a team from the previous season of the same or higher classification will be considered a returning team.

ILLEGAL PLAYER PARTICIPATION

- Any player(s), and the MANAGER, along with the entire team, may be suspended up to an entire year for roster violations.

TEAMS REQUESTING RECLASSIFICATION

- Contact the State Director to get a “Classification Appeal Form.” Minnesota USSSA’s classification committee meets monthly. Appeals will not be considered unless proper form is completed.
