*In the above programs any homerun over the limit results in an out! Except where noted in the "E" program and Mixed "E" program, any home run results in that position in the batting order being an out each time that position comes to bat. He/She may play in the field, but an out will be recorded each time that position comes to bat and it is also an inning ending out.

Mixed 1 1/12" Classifications:

Mixed "C" - For teams made up of male players that play no higher than Men's "C" and female players that play no higher than Women's "B".

Mixed "D" - For teams made up of male players that play no higher than Men's "D" and female players that play no higher than Women's "C".

Mixed "E" - For teams made up of male players that play no higher than Men's "E" and female players that play no higher than Women's "D".

Mixed World Tournaments - Teams will be allowed to add up to three players of higher classification. All add ons for world tournaments must be approved by the state director.

Softballs:

Regular Season

All softballs used in MRPA-USSSA games should be blue-stitched or blue-lettered and stamped with the USSSA logo. We will use a Dudley Classic M & Classic W optic yellow ball in our Regional and State Tournaments.

Eligibility:

35 & 40 Over Team Eligibility for Tournament Play:

- 35 & 40 and over teams may play in open "C" tournaments.
- Any individual 40 and over will be classified no higher than "C".
